

THE SOCIETY OF SHAVED APES (S.O.S.A.)

Revised summarised background information of 23 December 2013.

S.O.S.A. is a network of professionally skilled persons who share legally, information, to assist each other in the workplace and sometimes provide philanthropic assistance through the network. It is not in any way 'Masonic' or religious as organisation, though does involve some persons with a self-claimed 'faith'. The members meet in groups of two or more, sometimes in garden sheds, and together form collectively 'The Flange'. It is not a 'secret society', though operates in a way which sometimes keeps confidences. S.O.S.A. does not keep any crime information from the police or relevant authorities. The current public contact point for S.O.S.A. is Peter James Trapani. S.O.S.A. is not a registered charity and does not claim to be either. Any third party charitable support is purely undertaken out of choice, sometimes through apportionment of percentage of fees to a specific small set of charities, all of whom provide accurate acceptable accounting data without showing indignancy. SOSA reserves the right to refuse requests for money and is not aimed at providing money to drug rehabilitation centres or patching up failures in the tax system where not providing a national health service. The Flange members are not the 'shaved apes' referenced in a product title, though may utilise income generated through the legal exploitation of some intellectual properties.
